

MYSTIC UNDERGROUND WORLD OF ŠKOCJAN CAVES



We invite you to visit Škocjan Caves, the gem of Karst Slovenia with us this Wednesday. Škocjan Caves have a significant position among the world's natural monuments and are located on UNESCO's list of natural and cultural world heritage sites since 1986. Together with that, the Park joined the Alpine Network of Protected Areas and was entered in the Ramsar Directory of Wetlands of international importance.

Join us and explore this mystic underground world that was formed by the Reka river. The amazing canyon is what distinguishes Škocjan Caves from others. Here you can acquaint yourself with distinctive aboveground and subterranean Karst phenomena, see lots of endemic species – including the salamander, explore beauties of silent and murmuring cave. After the visit you will be taken to the Park's conference center, where wine tasting will wake up your taste buds. They will be spoiled even more with delicious local treats from the Karst region, known also as the gastronomic haven of Slovenia.

The departure for the Caves will be from the Faculty of Electrical Engineering, more precisely the bus station near the Faculty towards the Ljubljana centre. The bus will take us to the caves, which we will explore by foot with estimated walking time of 1 hour 45 minutes. **We strongly recommend you bring warm clothing and footwear suitable for slippery cave terrain (sneakers, walking shoes).**
